## **Connecticut Chefs Association's SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES**

**Scholarships are open to any student enrolled in an accredited culinary program.**

### **Requirements**

- Must have completed first academic year in a culinary program (i.e. nutrition, food management, etc.)
- Complete School Transcripts
- Two Academic letters of reference
- Scholarships are awarded on an as needed basis, which may require proof of financial need.
- Applications must be submitted and dated no later than September 1<sup>st</sup> for the following Spring Semester and by March 1<sup>st</sup> for the following Fall Semester.
- Written essay (250 words minimum). Topic: “Why am I pursuing a career in the culinary arts or related field”?
